2. 30 HOURS FREE CHILDCARE FOR WORKING PARENTS

3. FREE CHILDCARE FOR 2-YEAR-OLDS

All 2-year-olds are also eligible for 15 hours of free childcare per week. This funding is available to families receiving certain benefits or on low incomes, ensuring that more children have access to early education and its many advantages.

4. EXTENDED OFFER FROM 9 MONTHS
